Aims and Objectives

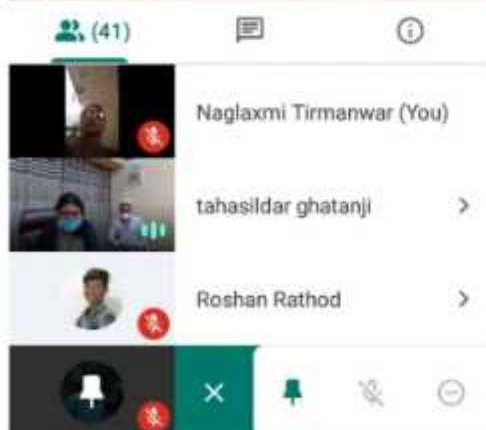
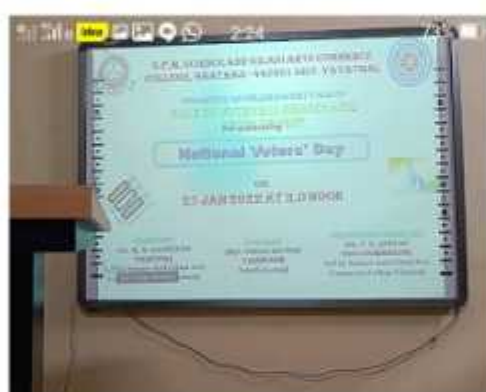
